



Student Lesson Skipping Policy

Purpose

This policy outlines the consequences for students who choose to skip lessons without proper authorization. The policy aims to maintain academic integrity and ensure consistent attendance in all classes.

Definition of Skipping

Skipping is defined as being absent from a scheduled lesson without:

- Prior written permission
- Valid medical excuse
- Documented emergency
- Other authorized absence approved by administration

Progressive Consequences

First Occurrence

- First written warning issued to student
- Parents/guardians notified
- Documentation placed in student's file

Second Occurrence

- Second written warning issued to student
- Parents/guardians notified
- Mandatory meeting may be scheduled with administration
- Documentation placed in student's file

Third Occurrence

- One (1) day suspension from school
- Parents/guardians notified
- Documentation placed in student's file





Academic Consequences

Any student who skips a lesson will face the following academic penalties:

- Tests taken on the day of skipping: Zero (0) grade
- Quizzes taken on the day of skipping: Zero (0) grade
- Classwork assigned on the day of skipping: Zero (0) grade
- No make-up opportunities will be provided for work missed due to skipping

Important Notes

1. All incidents of skipping will be documented and maintained in the student's disciplinary record
2. Parents/guardians will be notified for each occurrence
3. Repeated violations beyond the third occurrence may result in additional disciplinary action
4. This policy applies to all classes and scheduled academic activities
5. Students with repeated violations will not be eligible to receive recommendation letters from the school
